RULES & REGULATIONS FOR GOJU-KAI VICTORIA ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES FOR INSTRUCTORS

Instructors are:

1. To act in a professional, orderly and respectful manner at all times while in the dojo and at any event hosted by the Victorian Goju-Kai Division.
2. To display a Goju-Kai logo (fist) on their *dogi* at all times.
3. To report to the person in charge of the dojo, any breaches of misconduct. This must be in writing and signed by the person reporting the complaint.
4. To have a current First Aid Certificate
5. Must have a current 'Working with Children Check' if teaching children.
6. In case of injury in the dojo:
 - (a) Render assistance, and evaluate injury
 - (b) Fill out a formal 'Injury Report Form' and hand to the person in charge of the dojo. (A copy can be obtained from Chief Instructor Victoria)
7. Instructors must not fraternize with students, inside or outside the dojo.
8. Attend from time to time Instructor training workshops and / or seminars with the Branch Chief and Iwan Shihan in order to update knowledge, skills and all aspects of teaching standards.
9. When an official member commits an act, which harms the prestige and reputation of the I.K.G.A., and does not comply with the Rules and Regulations of the I.K.G.A., the consequence of their action may include the cancellation of his or her qualifications, depending on the severity of the act, or punishment such as expulsion from the I.K.G.A.
